RE: COVID-19 | Lockdown Level 4 Notice

We trust that this letter finds you well. In response to the Presidential address to adopt a **phased approach to easing the Covid-19 lockdown** – please take note of the following:

All AIE Students (Midrand and Cape Town)

1. From **1 May 2020**, the country will start the implementation of **Level four** of the phase in approach, which will mean that some economic activity will resume.
2. AIE has taken a situational response-based approach in line with the government's response strategy.
3. We **await further clarification** from Minister Blade Nzimande on the **impact of the Level 4 restrictions on specific educational institutions** and the allowance of access to your campus.
4. Until such time that further correspondence has been received from the Minister or President clarifying the terms, virtual classes will continue uninterrupted (Amended timetables to be released soon).
5. AIE will continue to communicate with students early next week and continually to do so as the economic circumstances changes.
6. **AIE sales, operational and academic staff** continue to operate at full capacity in a remote environment and is here to support you every step of the way.
